ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR AFRICA



BACHELOR

ENTRY CRITERIA

1. Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate (WASSCE), A Levels and O Level (subject related)
2. Grade 10th – 12th transcript or marksheet (minimum 50% of overall GPA)
3. Copy of passport
4. Resume
5. English test: IELTS (min. Level 5), TOEFL (min. 64 points), Cambridge (minimum Grade B), Duolingo 85 points (subject to local embassy) or MOI

***All 5 documents above are compulsory to start the admission evaluation.**

Pathway Program (Foundation Program)

- Duration 1 year in Bad Honnef only
- Price **10,997 EUR** for 1 year
- Applied for all students that graduated High School - 12th grade
- If students have 1-year university education, Pathway can be waived
- Student Job is not allowed during Pathway study

DIRECT BACHELOR

ENTRY CRITERIA

1. Higher National Diploma, KACE/KCE* (for Kenya)
2. Transcript or marksheet (minimum 50% of overall GPA)
3. Copy of passport
4. Resume
5. English test: IELTS (min. Level 6), TOEFL (min. 80 points), Cambridge (minimum Grade B), Duolingo 95 points (subject to local embassy)

***All 5 documents above are compulsory to start the admission evaluation.**

***KACE/KCE**

There must be a total of five independent general education subjects that have been passed on one examination date for each examination category (KCE or KACE). If they were taken on different examination dates, both subjects must be proven with a grade of at least C at the Principal (Advanced) Level. In both cases, the "credit" range (1-6) counts as a passing range for subjects in the KCE.

2 subjects at the Principal (Advanced) level in KACE and 3 subjects in the KCE they must be all subject related

ENTRY CRITERIA for Ghana

1. A Levels and O Level (subject related):
 - 3 subjects in O Level (min. grade 6) and 3 subjects in A Levels. These 6 subjects need to be independent and general and must include English and 1 maths/science subject. The subject “General paper” can only be taken I not account as O Level/subsidiary pass
 - Business degree: subject related to the studies in A Level
 - Technical degree: 2 subjects in A Level and 1 subject in O Level related to studies
2. Copy of passport
3. Resume
4. English test: IELTS (min. Level 5), TOEFL (min. 64 points), Cambridge (minimum Grade B), Duolingo 85 points (subject to local embassy) or MOI

***All 4 documents above are compulsory to start the admission evaluation.**

ENTRY CRITERIA for Nigeria

1. A Levels and O Level (subject related):
 - 2 subjects in A Level and 3 subjects in O Level (min grade 6) or 3 subjects in School Certificate (min grade 6). They have to be independent and general including maths, science and English.
 - Business degree: subject related to the studies in A Level
 - Technical degree: 3 subjects in A Level or 1 subject in A Level and 2 subjects in O Level related to studies
2. Copy of passport
3. Resume
4. English test: IELTS (min. Level 5), TOEFL (min. 64 points), Cambridge (minimum Grade B), Duolingo 85 points (subject to local embassy) or MOI

***All 4 documents above are compulsory to start the admission evaluation.**

DIRECT BACHELOR

ENTRY CRITERIA for South Africa

1. National Senior Certificate / Matriculation Certificate *

National certificate must show evidence of 7 general subjects with at least grade 4, including mathematics, 2 languages, life orientation and 3 other general subjects that are independent of one another, including 1 scientific subject.

Matriculation certificate must include proof of 6 general education subjects in "Higher Grade" with at least a grade of C, including mathematics, 1 scientific subject and 2 languages.

2. Copy of passport

3. Resume

4. English test: IELTS (min. Level 6), TOEFL (min. 80 points), Cambridge (minimum Grade B), Duolingo 95 points (subject to local embassy)

***All 4 documents above are compulsory to start the admission evaluation.**

***Matriculation Certificate** can be recognized as proof of university entrance qualification, if it marked "Pass: Matriculation Certificate"

ENTRY CRITERIA for South Africa

1. A Levels and O Level (subject related):
 - 2 subjects in A Level and 3 subjects in O Level (min grade 6) or 3 subjects in School Certificate (min grade 6). They have to be independent and general including maths, science and English.
 - Business degree: subject related to the studies in A Level
 - Technical degree: 3 subjects in A Level or 1 subject in A Level and 2 subjects in O Level related to studies
2. Copy of passport
3. Resume
4. English test: IELTS (min. Level 5), TOEFL (min. 64 points), Cambridge (minimum Grade B), Duolingo 85 points (subject to local embassy) or MOI

***All 4 documents above are compulsory to start the admission evaluation.**

M.A. MANAGEMENT 1 YEAR PROGRAM

ENTRY CRITERIA

1. Bachelor's degree certificate / Provisional Certificate / Graduation Certificate
2. Consolidated transcript or marksheet + grading scale (given by the university)
3. Copy of int. passport
4. Resume
5. English test: TOEFL (80 points), IELTS (Level 6), Cambridge (Grade B), Duolingo 95 points (subject to local embassy)

***All 5 documents above are compulsory to start the admission evaluation.**

6. Work Experience Certificate proven **1-year** working experience after bachelor graduation

*Note: offered-position letter, acceptance letter, resignation letter, pay slips, work contract are not considered as work experience certificate.

Following Programs do not require work experience but require related study field.

- M.Sc. Computer Science 120ECTS - 2 years
- M.A. International Management with majors 120ECTS – 2 years
- M.Eng. Engineering Management 60ECTS – 1 year
